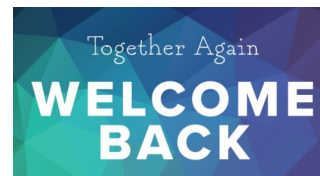
Psalm: 98

Please keep at least 1 metre apart from anyone who is not in your household, and wear a mask when you are in the church.

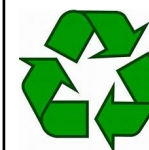
