Please note that numbers attending will be limited, with mask wearing and social distancing required as it is most likely that we will still be in Covid Alert Level 2.

The Parish Vestry has made the decision that refreshments will not be served after the services as we are unable to comply with the requirements set down in the current Public Health Order. They also decided that quiet congregational singing, while wearing masks, is to be introduced at services from the Third Sunday of Advent (12 December).



As long as Delta is in our country Communion will be in "one kind", that is the liturgical assistants and congregation receive the wafer only. Communion will be distributed from the step into the sanctuary. Please keep at least 1 metre away from those who are not in your household and wear your mask when you come forward. Please extend your arms and hands to maintain physical distance, and the priest will drop rather than place the wafer in your hands. You are then invited to lift your mask and consume the wafer before you return to your seat.

The St Peter's Chancel Choir is presenting a Service of Music and Readings for Advent **tonight at 7pm**. The 2021 Service of Music and Readings for Advent has been adapted as Covid-19 continues to change the ways we can meet in enclosed spaces. You will be expected to observe Social Distancing, Mask Wearing and Sign-in with the Tracer App or on the Sign-in Sheets provided.
