At our Eucharist bread and wine are offered from standing stations in the Church, the Vicar or Presiding Priest will notify you where the stations are situated. **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES IS INTINCTION (DIPPING) OF BREAD INTO WINE PERMITTED.** If this occurs then a fresh chalice of wine has to be prepared for the remainder of the congregation.
